NUS Conference takes place each spring, runs for three days and has almost 1400 people attending. This year the conference is being held in Brighton and will run from 25-27 April.

All delegates would need to be available to attend on these dates.

There will also be a range of 'fringe' events during the breaks which will look at national campaigns and other activities.

All expenses are paid for your attendance, including travel, accommodation and registration.

Any registered student is eligible to be a candidate for NUS Delegate.
