WELCOME.

Royal Holloway Students' Union exists for one simple reason: to make student life better at Royal Holloway. As a registered charity with a turnover of approximately £5m, it employs nearly 50 permanent staff and over 350 student staff, delivering a range of services from bars, shops, an advice centre, sports clubs, societies, media groups and supporting academic reps and campaigners.

ROLE DETAILS.

College Council is the governing body of Royal Holloway with responsibility for setting the overall strategic direction of the institution, and for making big decisions like appointing the Principal or approving new buildings like the Emily Wilding Davison Building.

There are 25 members of the Council – a mixture of current Royal Holloway staff, students and 16 individuals from outside of the College who are selected on the basis of their skills and experience. Each lay member is initially appointed for five years.

This role will be responsible for making sure that students have a voice feeding into the decision making at the College. The role will work alongside the President to report on student experience on campus and look at how student needs are represented in this forum.
